Electronics and computers contain hazardous materials that may harm the environment if disposed of improperly. The average CRT monitor, for example, contains five to eight pounds of lead. According to the EPA reusing one computer and monitor saves over 1,000lbs of green house gases (CO2) from being emitted.

Donations of used electronics will be collected at Goodale Park's Dennison Avenue parking lot. Donations shall be recycled or refurbished and redistributed to local, national, or international families in need. Donations are tax deductible, and donation receipts are issued at time of donation.
